**RESOLUTION :-**

**Under Government Resolution, Urban Development, Public Health and Housing Department, No.MUN(M)/4367/6822/N, dated 14<sup>th</sup> August, 1967, instruction were issued to the Municipal Councils to consider favourably the applications received from the Co-operative Societies of Fisheries, for leasing the Municipal tanks, etc. to them for purposes of fisheries development. In slight modification of the instruction issued in the above said Government Resolution, Government is pleased to direct that the Municipal Councils which can comply with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Maharashtra Municipalities Act-1965 and are in a position to pass a resolution by a majority of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the total number of Councillors, may lease their tanks to the Co-operative Societies for a period of 5 years in the first instance after obtaining the sanction of Government under section 92 (1) of the Act. The other Municipal Councils which cannot comply with the provisions of sub-section (2) of Section-92 of the Act, may lease their tanks to the Co-operative Societies for a period of 3 years in the first instance under Section-92 (3) of the Act. Such lease may, however, be renewed further after obtaining sanction of Government under Section-92 (1) of the Act in case the Municipal Councils are then in a position to pass a resolution by a majority of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the total number of Councilors as required under section 92 (2) of the Act.**
