CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. MATSYMA 1084/26890/(CR. 2/84)/ADF-12.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Mechanic (Aquarium) Class-III in the Directorate of Fisheries under the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Mechanic (Aquarium) Class-III (Recruitment) Rules, 1989.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise, "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Mechanic (Aquarium) in the Directorate of Fisheries shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Field Collector having not less than three years service in the post and possessing qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (b); or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than twenty-eight years age;

(ii) possess wireman certificate from Public Works Department of Government or of any institution recognised by Government; and

(iii) possess practical experience gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (i) for a period of not less than three years.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (iii) of clause (b) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the selection committee is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancy reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Schedule Caste converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, the committee may, in the matter of such selection relax the requirement in respect of the period of experience set out therein and select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes.

5. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of one year.
