RESOLUTION: In supersession of the existing recruitment rule prescribed for the post of Senior Clerk in the Department of Fisheries, Government is now pleased to approve the accompanying recruitment rule for the post of Senior Clerk in the Department of Fisheries.

2. Selection of candidates to be appointed by nomination should be made by three departmental officers namely (i) Deputy Director of Fisheries (General) (ii) Assistant Director of Fisheries (General) and (iii) Personal Assistant to Director of Fisheries who should prescribe a suitable test for the selection of candidates, set and examine papers, and declare results etc.

3. The recruitment rule in question should be included in the consolidated report called for in Government Circular, Political and Services Department, No. RTR 1058-M, dated the 15th February, 1958.

Recruitment Rule for the post of Senior Clerk.

Appointment to the post shall be made either -

(A) by promotion of a suitable junior clerk, cashier,
store keeper, typist or typist-clerk who have experience
of at least three years

or

(B) by nomination from among candidates who

i) If not already in the service of the Government
of Maharashtra are not more than 25 years and;

ii) hold a degree in arts, science, commerce or Law
of a recognised university.

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in the case
of candidates possessing good qualifications and/or experience.

2. Appointments shall be made by promotion and nomination
in the ratio of (1:2) 2:1.

3. A person appointed either by promotion or by nomination
shall be required to pass an Examination in Hindi and the
departmental Accounts Test according to the prescribed rules.
